WOUND CARE

☐ Gauze pads (various sizes)

☐ Gauze rolls

☐ Adhesive tape (pet-safe)

☐ Non-stick bandages

☐ Cotton balls & swabs

☐ Blunt-tipped scissors

☐ Tweezers

CLEANING

☐ Antiseptic solution (chlorhexidine or betadine)

☐ Saline solution (eye wash)

☐ Hydrogen peroxide 3% (vet use only)

MEDICATIONS

☐ Antibiotic ointment (original Neosporin)

☐ Antihistamine (Benadryl)

☐ Styptic powder (for bleeding nails)

☐ Activated charcoal (vet only)

TOOLS

☐ Digital thermometer

☐ Muzzle (soft)

☐ Disposable gloves

☐ Emergency Mylar blanket

☐ Cold pack

☐ Flashlight (with batteries)

DOCUMENTS

☐ Vet phone number

☐ Emergency vet phone number

☐ ASPCA Poison Control: (888) 426-4435

☐ Vaccination records (copy)

☐ Medical history (allergies/conditions)

WHAT NOT TO INCLUDE

☐ Ibuprofen / Tylenol / Aleve

☐ Human bandages (Band-Aids)

☐ Tea tree oil

☐ Rubbing alcohol

QUICK EMERGENCY REFERENCE

Problem	Action
Bleeding	Gauze + firm pressure 3–5 min
Broken nail	Styptic powder or cornstarch + pressure
Bee sting	Remove stinger + cold pack + call vet for Benadryl dose
Toxin eaten	Call vet or Poison Control NOW – do NOT induce vomiting unless told
Normal temp	101–102.5°F (over 103.5°F or under 99°F = emergency)

Store kit in waterproof container. Check every 3 months.

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
